FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** Does the L430 have the eInk display?
- A:** No, the L430 will always return to the “locked” state; therefore eliminating the need for the visual indicator.
- Q:** If I have a IR2-S Key (PK4400-S), will it still work on the new L430
- A:** Yes, the IR2-S Key is compatible with all Smart Locks. The IR2-S will provide an audible “error” message if digital handshake is not completed when unlocking the L430. However, since the L430 always returns to the locked position the audible feedback to remind the associate to re-lock a cabinet does not sound. The IR2-S Key is an ideal Key solution in a retail environment of surface mounted locks and the L430 Lock.
- Q:** Can the L430 be installed as a retrofit to an existing locking cabinet?
- A:** Yes. Because the lock installs from behind, the L430 can be installed on existing locking cabinets.
